**CALL TO ORDER**

Chairman Roberts called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.

**CONSENT AGENDA**

Commissioner Vaughan moved to approve the Consent Agenda, as follows:

- Approval of minutes of the county commission meeting on May 25, 2022
- Approval of AP payment vouchers
- Add-on – Bigley Road Vacation added to new business

Commissioner Dixon seconded; the vote was unanimous.

**PRESENTATIONS AND AWARDS AND PROCLAMATION**

Proclamation - Kansas Business Appreciation Month June 1<sup>st</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup>. Commissioner Pretz moved to approve as presented, Commissioner Dixon seconded; the vote was unanimous.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Bob Bigley, 17745 W 373<sup>rd</sup> Street and Jason Pruitt, 37107 Ridgeview Road, requested that the commissioners accept the petition that they were presented with last week. Shelley Woodard, County Counselor, clarified the process that accepting the petition would initiate and included that the petitioners had paid the \$500 bond to the County Clerk. Commissioner Pretz moved to approve as presented, Commissioner Vaughan seconded; the vote was unanimous.

Chairman Roberts presented a Resolution attaching territory to Rural Water District 2 in Miami County, Kansas. Commissioner Pretz moved to approve as presented, Commissioner Dixon seconded; the vote was unanimous. (R22-06-028)

Chairman Roberts presented a Resolution of findings of a nuisance hearing in Miami County, Kansas. Dave Delp, Building Codes Director, stated that he felt the counts as written, were good. Commissioner Vaughan moved to approve as presented, Commissioner Dixon seconded; the vote was unanimous. (R22-06-029)

Janet White, County Clerk, stated there was a Special Party Permit for Paola Alumni Festival June 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>. Chairman Roberts moved to approve as presented, Commissioner Vaughan seconded; the vote was unanimous.

**STAFF COMMENTS**

JR McMahon, Road & Bridge Director, presented the Priority System that his department has been implementing. He stated that because of the rain, they currently are in a Level 1 situation. Staffing issues have also been affecting the department's abilities to respond. The commissioners discussed how best to address where changes can be made, which Mr. McMahon agreed would need to be discussed further.
